

MODNET

MODNET is a Marie Curie Research Training Network in **Model Theory and Applications**, funded by Contract FP6-MRTN-CT-2004-512234 from the CEC. It is designed to promote training and research in **Model Theory**, a part of mathematical logic dealing with abstract structures, and having strong connections with and **applications to other areas of mathematics** (Diophantine geometry, Analytic geometry...). It unites 14 European teams, centered at the Universities of East Anglia, Paris 7, Leeds, Lyon, Oxford, Freiburg, Mons, Manchester, Haifa, Wroclaw, Camerino, Barcelona, Ankara and Berlin.

MODNET postdoctoral positions are currently available at the following locations. Starting dates are flexible.

- Université Lyon I (12 months, starting 1 September or 1 October 2007)
- University of Leeds (12 months, starting between 1 June and 1 October 2007)
- University of Camerino (6 months, starting before 1 October 2007)
- University of Barcelona (9 months, starting 1 September 2007)

The closing date for applications is **30 March 2007**.

MODNET visiting PhD positions are available at the following locations. Start dates are flexible; applications for 6 month positions will be considered. Applications will be considered when received.

- Université Lyon I (6 months, starting 1 September or 1 October 2007)
- Universität Freiburg (6 months, starting 1 October 2007)
- Université Mons-Hainaut (12 months, starting 1 October 2007)
